Solair Power Screens are custom manufactured to fit most standard and oversized applications. Installed by trained professionals, screens can be built-in during the time of construction to fit archways and other custom architectural structures. In addition to decks and patios, the Solair Power Screen can also be installed on garage openings to create a screened-in workshop.

The Solair Power Screen is offered in a variety of screening and shading options, depending on customer preference. Super Screen Insect Mesh reduces up to 35 percent of UV rays and is tear and puncture resistant. Solar Screen Mesh blocks out 85% of the sun's heat, glare and UV rays, reducing solar heat gain by up to 70% and lowering the inside temperature by up to 15 degrees. The Solair Power Screen can also be installed with Privacy Material, which provides up to 100% blockage of UV rays and is ideal for home theatre rooms.

Utilizing the latest in screen technology, Solair Power Screen is not only fire retardant, but also an industry leader in puncture, tear and mildew resistant technology. It is five times stronger than traditional fiberglass mesh. Manufactured with the highest grade aluminum and nylon components, Solair Power Screen stands up to the toughest environments.

The patent pending SRS fabric retention system keeps the screen from blowing out during windy conditions up to 75 miles per hour. The Solair Power Screen is backed by a limited 10-year warranty.
